# The Application Process



# School and work experience

- This is vital to show that you understand what being a teacher is all about
- Minimum of 10 days experience
- Show in your personal statement what you have learnt from your experience
- If you haven't done it yet, show that it is organised to be done soon
- You will be expected to draw on your experience at all stages of the process



# Personal statement

- This is where you get to show case yourself and is probably the most important part of your application
- Read through the personal statements and highlight the areas which you think are high quality (to help you) and the areas that you would change (so you don't make the same mistakes)

# Referees

- Make sure that you have asked the people you will use as a referee before applying
- Ask them to reply to the referee request as soon as possible after getting it as this can slow down the process

Pre organised activity (presentation)

Group task
