- Relevant degree (usually 2:1 or above) or a subject knowledge enhancement course
- High quality personal statement
- Relevant experience in the right age group – this can be organised but not completed, at least 10 days
- Demonstrate a passion for your subject area and teaching
- 2 referees ready to go
- TELA UCAS application support 1st Nov 6.30-7.30
